Seneschal's Report for July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Since last council I have completed organizing the files of my office and have progressed in completing the Seneschal's Handbook. Seneschal's Handbook still needs a few things copied and added.

I would like to remind all officers to keep their office Handbook's up to date. Add in any Lionsdale relevant info and suggestions as well as any changes with Policy in Lionsdale, or Laws in the governing documents (Corpora / Kingdom Law / Principality Law)

Change of office forms have been sent in for Tomas and Thora for seneschal change over in August. We are tentatively planning a ceremonial change over at Odin's Play Ground in September, the idea being to start behaving like a Barony. Regarding progress on Barony stuff: Eisenmarch is talking about having a shut down date of December 31, 2010. So that coincides with year end. This will allow them to complete the rest of their events on the calendar and finish all the financials. They will be confirming this at their council.

Eisenmarch and Lionsdale need to consider starting to report together as well (regarding process/progress) and should start to correlate offices. And then October, November and December it would be good to have a joint report for both groups, maybe even for the Third quarter if possible.
