Dance Report

Greetings unto the Seneschal of Lionsdale and its populace, the following is the full report for June AS43 being the year 2008.

- Lionsdale dance has occurred every Tuesday evening from 7:30 - 9:30 PM with attendance above 15 individuals each week.
- The first Lionsdale Sunday Social was held on May 25th with a total of 8 attendees, five of which were from Lionsgate. I am hoping a greater turnout will be present at the upcoming June 22nd Sunday social.
- At Lionsdale Champions, held June 6-8, 2008, dance occurred on Saturday and Sunday. There was a pretty good turnout, but I ended up waterbearing for the majority of the dancing. At Sealion war, June 13-14, 2008, there was also dancing for a short time. Very little interest was shown, so dance did not continue.
- It was decided at dance practice that the students enjoy the format we have compiled for the ball. Dances are chosen and practiced according to a set schedule for a two month period, with a variety of other dances to keep things interesting, then the last week before the ball, there is a

practice where dances are requested for final brush ups, the following week the ball is danced with as little calling and teaching as possible.

- The testing format for La Misura di Ballare has worked well with the less formal format. More applicants have successfully passed the testing with a less stressful format. Lady Tessa managed to compile a list of all dances tested as well as what is needed to pass that section for each applicant.
- Practices are continuing to go well with the new "Code of Conduct" in place. With the code of conduct in place, more dancing occurs rather than attention being called for.
- With the regular attendance of the Lions Gate dance group, the Lionsdale group has an influx of new dances on a regular basis.
- The Lionsdale dance group has seen an increase in the level of learning of the regular attendees, most with the ability to dance some of the more intricate and difficult dances with grace and ease.
