Items of note:

Prizes we were able to solicit donations in large. We did buy the knife blade and rattan (from the shire at cost) for a couple. Thank you to Their Highnesses of Tir Righ for sponsoring prizes and I donated a game board and pieces made for the event.

There was a misunderstanding on the site cost. I had contacted and suggested \$7/head (up from \$5 in 2010). They came back in the end of July after everything had already been advertised that they had a new price schedule but that they would work with us on it. The end result was \$7/head (adults and youth) plus \$1/head of people camping (actually stated as \$10/tent up to 10 people, but we estimated that we had 34 sleeping tents with unknown amounts of people in them, but based off of the number of people that were signed in at gate in relation to that that we had about 110 people camped.) and finally a flat fee of \$100 for use of the amenities on site (pool, pavilions, rotisserie, gazebo, showers, washrooms, etc.). It worked out in the end I think quiet well. And Eric was very apologetic to me for how things happened this year. I am satisfied with the results and think it is still worth going back there for next year.

Some of Oak's highlights:

-Watching Niko Olenson playing stick wrestling and literally throwing Thorin Olafson out of the ring! Plus watching him play "mother hen" and clean up to be Odin's Chosen! Congratulations Niko!~

-Watching Dr. Carus' trophy shot in spear beer! A few years ago this science minded man was showing me how to find my way at sea and this time how he can use a spear. There will always be room on my boat for a man like that!

Some of Thora's highlights:

-The kids making butter for the feast. That was so cool!

-Trying to find a hole to dig myself into to hide while Oak sang to me the reasons that he wanted to take me to Iceland.... "Whoooooooooooo if not youuuuuuuuu....." (with Haagar the Horrible as Documentation)

-Watching Princess Lenora have her first awards court!

-I passed on my comp to Baroness Glynis who actually came over on Wednesday from Victoria (taking time off work) and helped me Wednesday night thru until Sunday at about 1PM which is when she had to leave to go catch a ferry.
